Healthy Chicken Dinner

30 minutes of preparation/ Serves 4

Ingredients: (12)

- 1.667 cups chicken stock
- 0.375 cup white wine
- 1 celery stalk (chopped)
- 1 bunch parsley stem (tied together)
- 1 bay leaf
- 4 chicken breasts (skinned)
- 1 bunch baby carrots (trimmed)

add salt

add peppers

- 16 cherry tomatoes (halved and lightly seasoned to draw out the juices)
- 1 bunch basil leaves
- 2 slices lemons (finely chopped)

Preparation Steps:

- Bring the chicken stock and wine to the boil in a pan and add the celery and herbs.
- Add the chicken breasts and poach gently for around 10 minutes until cooked through and no pink juices run out when pierced with a knife. Remove from the stock and keep warm wrapped in foil.
- Add the carrots to the poaching liquor and cook at a gentle simmer until tender – about 10 minutes.
 Remove from the liquor and set aside.
- Reduce the poaching liquor by half and season.
- To serve, slice the chicken breasts thickly and arrange on a plate with the poached carrots. Scatter over the tomatoes, basil leaves and chopped lemon then drizzle with a tablespoon or two of the reduced poaching liquor.
