Community Health & Well-Being: Prescription for Health Program

Through the **Prescription for Health** program, providers give qualifying patients a prescription for our Prescription for Health program. This includes setting personal health goals, increasing consumption of fresh fruits and vegetables, and learning about health, food and nutrition. This innovative program addresses chronic health conditions, such as diabetes and hypertension, by removing food insecurity.

Clinical Excellence: Behavioral Health

As a leader in behavioral health, Trinity Health Grand Rapids has the only dedicated Psych-Med Unit (PMU) in Michigan. This 28-bed PMU serves those affected with a medical and psychiatric disorder using a patient and family-centered approach. We plan to continue our innovative and progressive approaches to further address the escalating behavioral health crisis and help provide comprehensive outpatient programming focusing on behavioral health integration.

Patient Experience: The Boutique at Lacks Cancer Center

Services at **The Boutique** are provided at no cost to patients. The relaxing and renewing services patients can receive here during or after cancer treatment include post-mastectomy or lumpectomy bras and bra fittings; head shavings; wigs and wig fittings and styling; and stylish, supportive and personal care. By supporting these services, your gift will help patients look and feel beautiful, and leave with more confidence and a larger support system.
